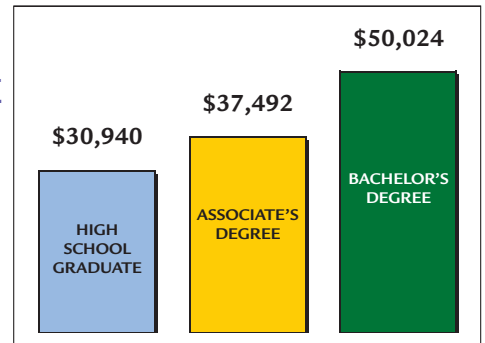


The Jeannette Rankin Foundation: Highlights

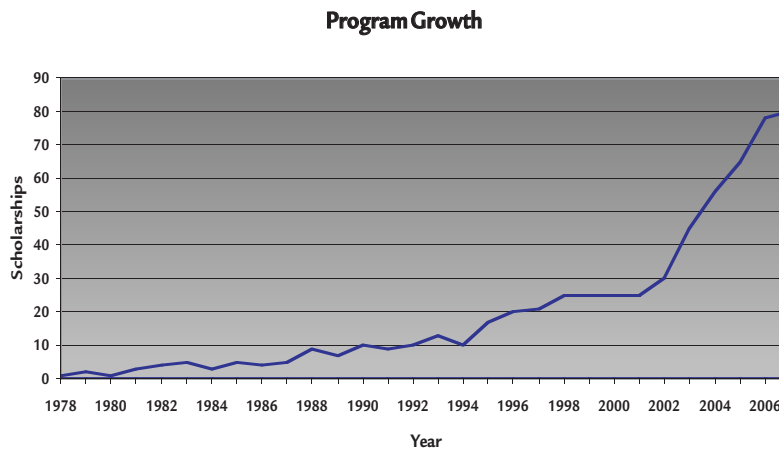

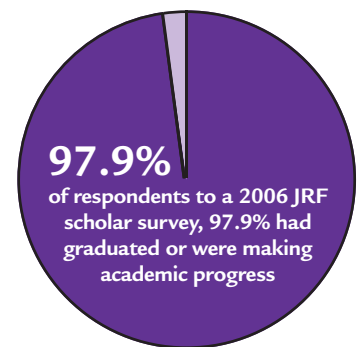

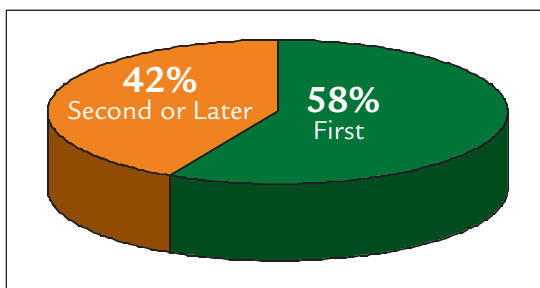

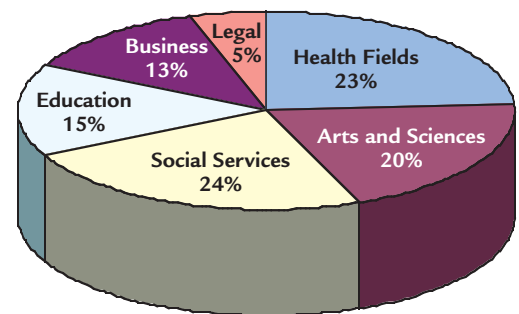

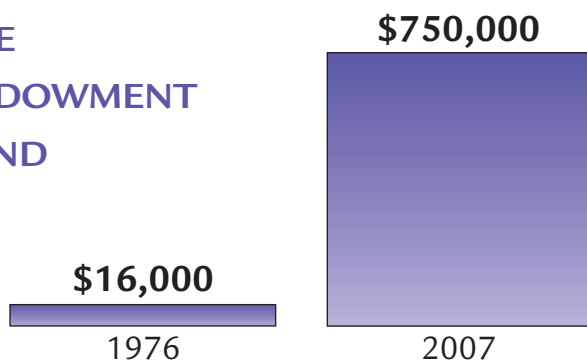
